#### LIBERTY PROPANE GAS SERVICE REMINDERS

- 1. Minimum gas delivery is 50 gallons.
- 2. Be sure to check your tank regularly. Order when the gauge reads 20%, so you do not run out.
- 3. In the event you do run out of propane or the tank is turned off, a Liberty Propane technician will have to be scheduled to do a pressure test and re light the pilots. This is a \$75.00 fee. Someone will need to

be home to allow us access to appliances inside the home. If you fail to meet your scheduled time, there may be an additional fee of \$75.00

4. We do not charge a deposit, therefore ALL accounts are C.O.D. Please have payment available at the time of service.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM YOUR PROPANE COMPANY

As your propane provider, we strive to deliver you a safe and efficient product. In order to ensure your continued safety, the Georgia propane industry worked with the Georgia Legislature for the passage of a new Georgia state law, SB139, regarding your system and appliances. It says that if you alter your LP-Gas

system or equipment in any way without informing your propane company, you assume the responsibility associated with any incident which may occur as a result of your alteration of that system.

So remember, if you plan to allow someone other than your propane company to alter your system or equipment, you must notify them immediately so they can perform the proper safety check of your system before it is activated. The law is designed to ensure that we can continue to provide you with the safest propane service available.



### Effective July 1, 2004 Georgia Statue SB139 states:

"A LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS PROVIDER SHALL BE IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY IF THE PROXIMATECAUSE OF THE INJURY OR DAMAGE WAS: 1) AN ALTERATION, MODIFICATION, OR REPAIR OF LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS EQUIPMENT THAT COULD NOT HAVE BEEN DISCOVERED BY THE LIQUIDIFIED PERTOLEUM GAS PROVIDER IN THE EXERCISE OF REASONABLE CARE:OR

2) THE USE OF LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS EQUIPMENT IN A MANNER OR FOR A PURPOSE OTHER THAN THAT WHICH THE LIQUIFIED PERTOLEUM GAS EQUIPMENT WAS INTENDED TO BE USED OR FOR WHICH COULD REASONABLY HAVE BEEN FORESEEN, PROVIDED THE LIQUIFIED GAS PROVIDER OR THE MANUFACTURER OF THE LIQUIFIED PERTOLEUM GAS EQUIPMENT HAS TAKEN REASONABLE STEPS TO WARN THE ULTIMATE CONSUMER OF THE HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE FORESEEABLE MISUSE OF THE LIQUID PERTOLEUM GAS EQUIPMENT.
